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Dear Parent or Guardian:

Contra Costa Health Services (CCHS) will offer a full range of health care services for students at several high schools throughout Liberty Union High School District. These services will include any of the following: healthy teen exams, sports physicals, immunizations, hearing, vision, and confidential services. A CCHS *Consent to Services and Conditions of Services and of Admission* form must be signed annually by a parent or guardian before a student can receive medical services, unless students are requesting confidential services. Which students qualify?

- Students who have health insurance through Medi-Cal and Contra Costa Health Plan are eligible to receive services.
- Students **without** health insurance may also receive limited services.
- Those students with Kaiser or other private health insurance will not be eligible for health care services by CCHS, but may receive assistance with making appointments or contacting their health care provider.
- All students regardless of insurance are eligible for confidential sensitive services.
