State Requirements

The state requires that an annual letter be sent to all EL parents at the beginning of the school year. This letter reviews the students CELDT level and states what the student's placement in ELD classes, etc. will be for the coming year. If the parents disagree with the placement, they are encouraged to meet with the staff and discuss their concerns.

Each year the CELDT scores are sent to the parents. If a parent retains these score sheet from year to year, they can see their student's progress

At the end of each grading period we are required to notify EL parents if their student has failed a class required for graduation. Again the parent is encouraged to meet with teachers or administrators to find way to support the student's success. This also makes the parent aware that a student is in danger of not graduating.

When a student is initially tested by our District, a letter is sent to the parents reporting the scores on the CELDT and what the student placement in ELD and or SDAIE classes will be. If the student tests Initially Fluent, the parents will be so notified. An IF student is not placed in the ELD program.
