The Delta Community Services (DCS) Brentwood High School Scholarship Program is intended to provide support to graduating high school seniors who are in need of financial support to continue their education in an accredited Vocational/Trade School, Community College, or University. The initial program will provide:

Three \$1,300 scholarships for graduating seniors from:

- Heritage High School
- Liberty High School
- Freedom High School

One \$1,000 scholarship for graduating seniors from

- La Paloma High School
- Independence High School

This will provide for a total of 11 scholarships at a cost of \$13,700. At the discretion of the DCS Board of Directors, based on the submitted scholarship nominations, the distribution of the scholarships across the five high schools may be adjusted.

The criteria for selection will be:

- Graduation from one of the five designated high schools
- Minimum 2.75 GPA (Flexibility for demonstrated improvement for La Paloma and Independence candidates)
- Proof of acceptance to Vocational/Trade School, Community College or University
- Nomination Submission Package:
 - Brief statement (< 500 words) of financial need and post-high school academic goals (Student)
 - Brief letter of support (high school faculty or administration)

Winners will be nominated by each of the high school administrations, subject to the approval of the DCS Education Committee.
