Credit by Examination Articulation Agreement**

Effective Date


This articulation agreement enables students who have successfully completed the **Liberty High School Teaching and Learning Careers Academy**, and who meet the **Los Medanos College** admission requirements, to receive 6 units of college credit for the articulated courses taken at Liberty High School. Upon the successful completion of Child Development 10 and 20 at Los Medanos College, with a grade of "C" or higher, students may apply to the Los Medanos College Admissions Office to receive 6 units of credit for Child Development 32 and 83 articulated with the Teaching and Learning Careers courses at Liberty High School.


Students should submit their official high school transcript or Certificate of Completion along with a copy of this agreement **within five years from completion of the coursework** to the Admissions Office at Los Medanos College to receive 6 units of credit for Child Development 32 and 33.


This agreement between Los Medanos College and Liberty High School Teaching and Learning Careers Academy shall remain in effect for 1 year after which it will be subject to review for renewal.


